AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered for the purpose of providing legal services. **NICK C. THOMPSON, ATTORNEY AT LAW**, agrees to represent the undersigned CLIENT from Wednesday, January 04, 2006, in the matters set out below, providing legal services at the client's direction, including an initial one hour of initial consultation, negotiation, document preparation, and or court appearances. No appeal work is contemplated in this Agreement. Additional work or an Appeal is an added cost of 150 per hour for in office work and 200.00 per hour for trial work. Travel time is billed as in office time. The undersigned CLIENT agrees to pay a sum of money as retainer to secure the services described herein and in the minimum amount of **\$500.00**. **Said sum is not refundable. The attorney fee for a DUI 1st is at least 500.00, for a DUI 2nd it is at least 1,000 dollars, and for a 3rd and 4th it is an amount over 1,000.00 dollars based upon the number of hours expected.** This does not include the additional time to needed to obtain a hardship license, obtain an expungment or file an appeal. Often these matters will require several court dates and appearances.

The undersigned CLIENT agrees to pay, in addition to attorney fees as set out herein, all court costs and expenses incidental to the representation and service provided. This is normally limited to the court costs and or counseling or court expenses but it can include expenses such as the cost of a deposition. The ATTORNEY agrees to provide CLIENT, from time to time, a statement identifying fees earned and balances due for services, and CLIENT agrees to make prompt payment in the month of received statements. Any balance of fees remaining unpaid after thirty (30) days shall earn interest at the rate of 1-1/2 percent per month until fully paid. No other service charges will be assessed; however, court costs and collection fees including reasonable attorney fees for collections will be assessed if the client should default in payment and a lawsuit to enforce payment of fees is filed. It is agreed that Nick C. Thompson may decline to provide representation upon completion of investigation of CLIENT'S legal status, non payment or upon any event that jeopardizes the attorney-client relationship as created by these offered services.
